Test with Ease

You can ace your test in three simple steps.

Step 1: Prepare

You are ready to become a teacher and decided that iteach is the right partner for you. Where do you start?

Content Area Identification:

- Your content area is identified based on your college coursework. Even if you feel like a pro in your content area, it is still key to prepare as much as possible before your content exam.
- If you want to teach outside of your college coursework content area, no problem!
 Just expect additional preparation will be necessary.

Test Preparation Resources

- If you are under a \$99 monthly plan, iteach will auto-enroll you into a third-party test preparation program so you have all the resources you need at your fingertips!
- There are many ways to prepare! Find the one that works best for you. Check out other recommended resources to help you study and take practice tests:

- We recommend preparing for your test at least two to three weeks before sitting for your exam.

Set up an account with Texas Education Agency

- Setting up an account only takes 10-20 minutes.
- How to set up TEA account?
 - Go to <u>tea.texas.gov</u> and click on ECOS for Educators at the top of the main page.
 - The site will walk you through the process of setting up your account.





Step 2: Request

You have prepared and feel ready to pass your exam! That means it is time to ask for test approval

iteach determines the readiness of each candidate to take the appropriate certification test. Test approval is not guaranteed and is based solely on program discretion and the candidate's demonstration of subject matter knowledge.

How to ask for test approval?

- You must be enrolled in the iteach program before requesting test approval.
- If your content area of interest was identified for program admission, go ahead and submit a test request for your content area by visiting your homepage in Instuctnet and clicking on Test Info/Request Test Approval.
- You are not required to test in your identification area of enrollment. You can be approved for a content test outside of that area by completing outside test preparation.
- Email <u>testing@iteach.net</u> with proof of passing scores from your test preparation provider for approval.
- Always expect 2-3 days before test approval is confirmed. You will receive an email confirming your approval and the email will provide registration instructions.
 - *All certification tests will be offered by Pearson

Additional Testing

We know not passing on your first attempt is a bummer, but we are here to help.

- If you were unsuccessful on your first attempt, email <u>testing@iteach.net</u> to request a second attempt.
- Before providing guidance and the proper resources to help you be successful in your second attempt, our team will analyze your test results to determine if another attempt will be approved.





Step 3: Take

Your request to take your test has been approved! You have registered for your exam and now the big day is here. Do not stress. You have prepared for this and you are ready to pass and get hired!

Register

- Follow this link to register for your exam.
- Expect your test day to be 3-4 days out.
- Remember, passing your content test is one of your pre-hire requirements to gain access to your Statement of Eligibility.

Calm Your Test Anxiety

Testing can be overwhelming, and anxiety before a big test is completely normal. Some ways to calm your test anxiety include:

- Prepare, prepare preparation can help calm anxiety by helping you know what to expect on the test.
- Clear your mind before the test.
 - Practice breathing techniques
 - Move your body go for a walk, run or dance it out
- Write down how you are feeling
- Talk to someone close to you
